The Holy Father is inviting all the faithful, of all the world, to pray the Holy Rosary every day during the month of October, and thus join in communion and in penitence, as the people of God, in asking Mary, the Holy Mother of God, and St. Michael Archangel to protect the Church from the devil, who always seeks to separate us from God and from one another. As part of this request, the Holy Father asks the faithful of all the world to pray that the Holy Mother of God place the Church beneath her protective mantle: to preserve her from the attacks of the devil, the great accuser, and, at the same time, to make her more aware of the faults, the errors, and the abuses committed in the present and in the past, and committed to combatting without any hesitation, so that evil may not prevail, using the following invocation:

We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin.

The Holy Father has also asked that the recitation of the Holy Rosary during the month of October conclude with the prayer written by Leo XIII:

Saint Michael Archangel, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.
